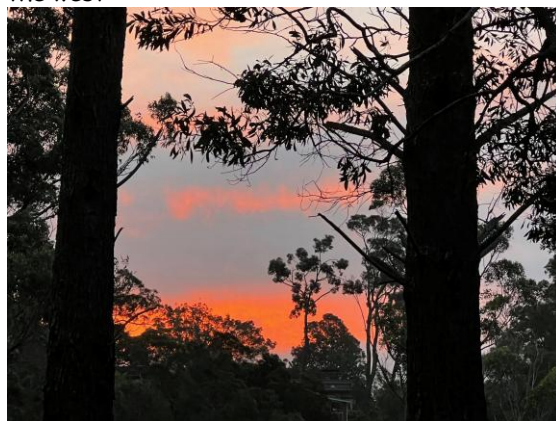
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Until the pack lobbed back at the scenic tranquil Wimbe Beach where a circle was convened and the pack did stuff while the sun set sublimely in the west

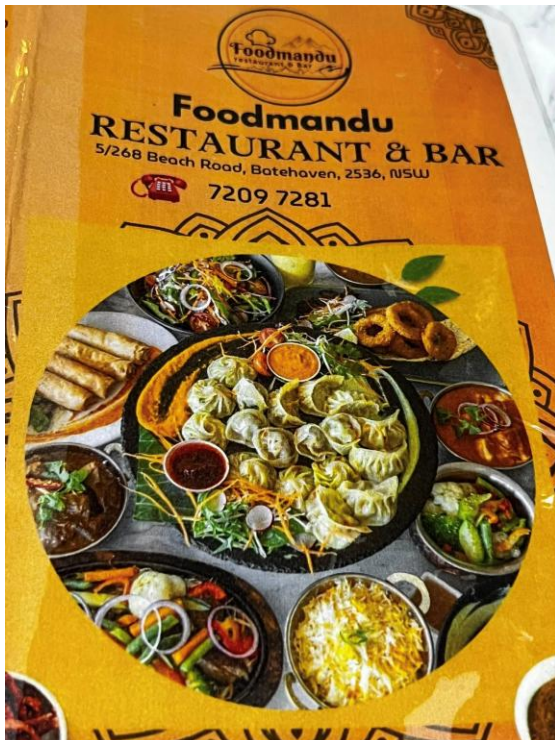
